Time for the Annual Auction at Our New Meeting Location!

Earlier this month the BARRA board finalized details with the St. Bart's congregation allowing us to continue our general meetings at their new church facility. The new church is located at 2368 Eggert Road in Tonawanda, near the intersection of Sheridan Drive and Eggert Road (map at right), just a few blocks from our old meeting location. To get to the new building from the old one, go south on Fries Road to the next traffic light, Eggert Road. Turn left, and go a few blocks until you are almost opposite the north entrance of the Office Depot Plaza. The driveway to the St. Bart's parking lot is on your right. We will be using the door on the building marked "School" in big silver letters.

The meeting room that we will be using is on the first floor, which is only a few steps up from street level, and the room is just inside the School entrance; quite a change from our basement "dwelling" at the old location.
