Recently Bruce Tennant, K6PZW, an author of many reports in "Arnewsline," discussed a change in the FCC.gov data base. It is called "Reboot.fcc.gov." Under the chairmanship of Julius Genachowski the web changes are supposed to initiate high levels of public interaction. It apparently has better ways to serve the public. Along with links to the "Universal Licensing System," and many



suggestion box routines, "Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, and live FCC broadcasts," each administrator in the system is positioned to disseminate information and answer questions.

Some of the categories listed in this site are: "events, initiatives, reform, FCC leadership, Blog, FCC gov/data, consolidated licensing system, helping Haiti, FCC reform, systems, rules and processes, data, engagement, and redesign." An amateur operator can also obtain FCC updates through e-mail. The changes make users feel like it's part of our own company; our tax dollars at work equals transparency. You can find this site at http://www.reboot.fcc.gov. I think it is a nice product, and there is big effort to connect bureaucracy to each of us in a personal manner.






