

## A Double Dose of Hobby Highlights

This year we will have another "Museum Ships on the Air" event. On June 4-5, 2011 Louise, KC2RBL, Kevin, WA2FKV, Art, NA3X, Paul, NA4ZI, as it is listed on the certificate, and myself KG2OR demonstrated our radio skills on the USS *Little Rock*, and received a beautiful picture of the ship, the W2PE call,



and our names and calls from the "Battleship New Jersey Amateur Radio Station."

Everything is positioned upon a grand certificate. I just received the file from Lee, KC2RBL, and downloaded the data into my printer and I am very impressed at the details, colors and background. This year the event hosted 78 ships from around the world. We were able to contact ships as far as Texas, NA5DV, USS *Texas*, some others in Massachusetts, K1USN, USS *Massachusetts*, N1EPL, and the U-5075, *Seehund* submarine. Many more were included, and we were on the air for some pile ups with our W2PE call too.

Please keep the next "Museum Ships on the Air" date in 2012 open for yourself, and on the Saturday and Sunday in June become a part of history and join the fun.

I have seen many people working in the club, and committing themselves to our hobby. It is one of the principles to promote it, and establish it in society as a public entity. Passing the exam and achieving a class of license is the ticket to privilege and it still is, even though we have seen so many changes.

In this "Hobby Highlights" I will focus on Robert Brock, K2LED, formerly KC2ZPH.

On January 16th, 2012 at around 7:15PM he called into the RAWNY Net from Las Vegas, Nevada. He was on Echo Link, and used the K2ILH repeater with Internet relay protocol. I said, "that has to be a RAWNY record for the net," a member's DX call on 70cm; the 440 WA2HKS repeater, and a concern for reporting using an Echo Link Internet protocol. The technology really impressed me. A couple of other things Bob is doing is also worth noting. He gives demonstrations to the club about light emitting diodes. I have become aware that he is starting a ham radio club at his daughter's high school; the big project in ARRL language, and he has set up a 70cm receiver on 434.825 MHz to assist the 146.415 MHz network in the area; the 440 receiver broadens the range for people receiving the two meter simplex network. I think he is promoting the hobby with a lot of zeal. This is the kind of "Hobby Highlights" I began many years ago; personal description and exposition.






