# January's Program: Annual Report of the BARRA Technical Committee



January's meeting program on Monday, January 17th will be the annual BARRA Technical Committee Report to the Membership on its actvities for the previous calendar year. The program, as in previous years, will contain a summary of each of the club's repeater sites, outlining

the equipment at each site, along with any improvements, repairs, or other tasks performed over the past year. There will be many photos of the activities that took place at each repeater location.

Failing a personal visit to each site, the January report to the membership is an excellent way for members to learn more about the repeaters that they use and support with their membership dues. Many of the repeater trustees will be in attendance that evening and it will be a great forum for meeting the folks who keep the machines up and running.

Assisting the repeater trustees is the BARRA Technical Committee, a semi-formal body of members who help to maintain the repeaters and the sites at which the machines reside. While the name of the committee suggests that they deal with the nitty-gritty of the electronic innards of the repeaters, and indeed they do, the Tech Committee also takes care of less "solderable" issues like physical plant maintenance at our flagship Cole Road repeater site. Indeed there will be a lengthy report about the significant upgrades to the original Cole Road building, known to all as "Chet's Shack" (pictured above), that were begun this past summer.

## Soccer Tournament Public Service Event May 28-29

As mentioned in last month's *Link*, BARRA has been contacted to provide communications for the Amherst International Memorial Soccer Tournament that will take place Memorial Day weekend, Saturday May 28th and Sunday May 29th. The board of directors have ap-



proved BARRA's participation. The event will take place at five locations throughout the Town of Amherst, and will see soccer matches taking place from 8 AM to 8 PM each day at each site.

Because of the widespread venues and multiple matches taking place at each site, the reporting of the results of each match is important to the event organizers in order to determine the pairing of teams in further games over the weekend. That is where we as hams come into play.

One ham would be posted at each of the five fields and would report the results of the games taking place at that field as each match is completed. The scores will be given to the hams by officials at the fields. A tent and picnic table is provided at each field for the ham and the field marshal who gathers the scores from that field. Any emergencies would be handled by cellular telephone calls to 911.

In previous years the event people have used cell phones but they ran into difficulties when the folks responsible for the phones would forget to charge them, or forget to turn them over to the folks on the next shift, leaving the organizers with no way of contacting a field.



Since there are so many locations to cover over 12 hours on each of two days, many volunteers will be needed. The communications that we need to provide are important, but not difficult, and will be a great opportunity for hams who have never participated in a public service event to get their feet wet in such an activity. More information will be presented to the volunteers as the event time approaches

and we will likely have meetings with some of the event personnel to go over what we will be doing and answer any questions.

If you would like to volunteer for a shift or two -- and the length of time is determined by your schedule -- please drop a note to the editor at ka2wft@arrl.net or sign up at a meeting. This is not limited to BARRA members only, so bring along any non-member ham friends, too.
