Hobby Highlights

As I read Arnewsline and the ARRL web site this month; I decided to envision my "Hobby Highlight" as electrifying as a solar storm. I found in the September 2006 RAWNY QSO an essay I wrote about "Sunspots." This writing helped me understand the "K7RA Solar Update." Cycle 24 is beginning to develop a significant sunspot. It is called "Sunspot



1035." The scientists are charting more solar flux, A, and K numbers. Thus, operators will experience better DX. The key is knowing how to time the DX call. Please see http://www.arnewsline.org, and http://www.arrl.org (K7RA Solar Update, and the appropriate links.)

I pointed out in my September 2006 "Hobby Highlight," that Carl Luetzelschwab, K9LA, had written, "The Sun, the Earth, the Ionosphere: What the Numbers Mean, and Propagation Predictions -- A Brief Introduction to Propagation and the major factors affecting it." He wrote about sunspots, atomic theory, coronal mass ejections, solar winds, the indexes, electromagnetic fields, and their role in exchanging electrons in the ionosphere; causing F layer splitting. http://www.arrl.org/tis/info/K9LA-prop.html. Along with this article, I read G3YWX, Ian Poole's work about sunspots. http://www.arrl.org/tis/info/pdf/0209038.pdf. Considering it takes a couple of days for a sunspot to affect our propagation, it's to our advantage to know what the solar numbers, flux, and A, and K indicies mean. So much for references; it's in those articles. And if you still have the September 2006 QSO I noted a couple of web sites defining solar structures. They appear in NOAA, and ASA.

Your best foundation for this science is to know the solar and flux numbers, A, K, and planetary A and K numbers. The technical path analysis for DX within "Cycle 24" will be more specialized; as to region and time, if you focus upon the charts, and follow the propagation reports.


