### 146.73 Repeater Has a New Home

The 146.73 K2ILH repeater has a new home in North Tonawanda. Faced with the ongoing problems at the "blue tarp" hotel in Niagara Falls, the club was beginning to explore options in the north towns for a new site. Earlier in the summer we were approached by Bob Schober, K2CRR, of Kenilworth Electronics who offered the club space at his two-way radio site on Shawnee Road in North Tonawanda. A bit of trivia about this site, it was the original transmitter location of WBEN and was featured in Scott Fybush's excellent presentation to us last spring about commercial radio transmitter sites.

The repeater was installed at the site and the necessary paperwork filed with the repeater council and the repeater has been on the air from that site since mid-summer. Preliminary reports are that the machine has good coverage from this new location. There are a couple of technical issues to resolve at the site, but the machine is already getting good reports.

The repeater's former home at the hotel location, dubbed the "blue tarp" motel by the Technical Committee since the hotel has changed names several times in the last few years, and at each name change there'd be a blue tarp over the sign until a new one was installed, has had serious difficulties since last summer. The location had a significant electrical problem and to this day still does not have power restored.

BARRA is most appreciative of K2CRR's kind offer to allow us to have the 146.73 machine at his site. Check out 146.73 if you haven't recently. It needs a 107.7 Hz CTCSS tone.
